1. The Folder

1.1 Introduction


The folder allows the exporter to group all the required information for an export container on a confirm booking and also to allow the integration of export Bill of Entry. With this function, the shipper can identify other stakeholders to allow them to view information pertaining to folder.

A folder should be associated to a confirm booking created by the shipping line.

The Folder is mandatory for the integration of the Bill of Entry in CCS, which will trigger the EGIN notification.

1.2 Creation of folder in CCS

The Shipper can use the rapid access function. The code can be found in brackets in the menu next to each function.

1. Type CDOSS in the box 
2. Click on the button "GO"

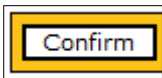



After the input of data has been completed by the shipper, the user will click on  and

CCS identification DOS0000XXXX will be generated by the CCS to inform the shipper that the folder has been created.

2. Search a Folder

After the creation of the folder, the shipper has the possibility to view or search same in CCS. The folder can be search by the rapid access function or by browsing the menu.

The code can be found in bracket in the menu next to each function.

2. Click on the button "GO"



The below screen will be displayed where the shipper will enter his DOS CCS ID in the field folder reference and click on search then on the modify button.



3. Contributor

The contributor is used to add other party on the folder created by the shipper to have access to view information in the folder.

Example as per below:

If the contributor is codified in CCS, the shipper will use the field CCS contributor to add the user.

4. Linked BOCO

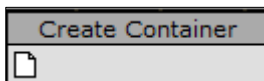
This function is used to link the shipping line CCS Booking Id to the folder. It is a reference generated by CCS after creation of the booking by the shipping line.

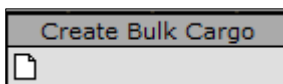


The linked TU is used to regroup all the consignments to be stuff in the container. Refer as per below screen:





